POSITION SUMMARY:

Camp Counsellors for Yonge Eglinton Community Centre’s *Camp Pal-O-Mine* support the supervision, safety, and engagement of children ages 4–12 while leading fun, inclusive camp activities for a diverse group of Midtown Toronto families. This is an 11-week summer position, including one week of orientation and training followed by 10 weeks of camp programming.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Supervise and ensure the safety, well-being, and care of children ages 4–12 participating in the summer day camp program.
- Education and/or experience in recreational programming, child development, and understanding of children’s developmental stages.
- Energetic, reliable team player with enthusiasm for working with children and strong attention to safety and detail.
- Demonstrated sensitivity to and respect for cultural, social, linguistic, and economic diversity; commitment to creating an inclusive environment for all participants.
- Excellent interpersonal and communication skills with children, parents/guardians, fellow staff, and volunteers.
- Ability to swim and participate in water-based activities.
